

**Minutes of Meeting of Gunlake Quarries Community Consultative Committee  
held at Marulan at 10.00am on 27 July 2018**

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**1) Attendance:**

The Chairman welcomed Tony Mulvihill as a new CCC community member.

**2) Apologies:** Cheryl Bell (CM), Angus Richmond (Gunlake).

**3) Declaration of pecuniary or other interests:**

- a) Tony Mulvihill declared that Gunlake had provided him with an air conditioner and an occasional load of gravel.
- b) Ron Switzer declared he has reached an agreement with Gunlake to provide approx. 300m of fencing where some of the road upgrades have affected his property.

**4) Minutes of meeting held on 09 March 2018 were confirmed, with an amendment to Item 7(g), deleting the words "which will" and inserting the words "and asked to"**

**5) Business arising from the Minutes:**

- a) Roadworks & Property Access – Ron Switzer has raised some issues with Council on the road upgrades such as batter stability, signage and speed limits. Council are currently investigating these issues.
- b) Noise Monitoring – EPA have informed the Chairman that a report on their noise monitoring at Dennis' property will be sent to the parties and any complaints relevant to the EPA should be sent via the CCC Chairman and will be investigated.
- c) Haul Route Speed Limit – See company report
- d) Provision of quarry production tonnages. Under the new consent Gunlake will provide 6 monthly summary of daily maximum and calendar monthly average truck numbers.
- e) Gunlake will update CCC when road upgrades are completed and signed off by GM Council.
- f) It was asked whether Section 94 contributions are used exclusively on the road for which they are collected. Scott Martin will investigate and advise the CCC at the next meeting.
