



# **GUNLAKE MARULAN QUARRY CONTINUATION PROJECT – COMMUNITY INFORMATION SESSION CANCELLATION**

## **Overview**

As notified in the Gunlake Quarry Newsletter (August 2021) and in the Discover Marulan August 2021 edition, a State Significant Development (SSD) application for the Gunlake Quarry Continuation Project is being prepared. The application will be made through the NSW Department of Planning, Industry and Environment (DPIE) and primarily will seek to:

- increase the tonnage of product transported along the Primary Transport Route; and
- extend the approval for quarry operations for 30 years.

There will be no changes to the currently approved disturbance area, hours of operation, blasting frequency, or the truck movements on the Secondary Transport Route.

EMM Consulting Pty Limited is currently preparing an environmental impact statement (EIS), to accompany the SSD application for the Gunlake Quarry Continuation Project.

## **Community Information Session Cancellation**

As notified in the recent Continuation Project Update (August 2021), a second Community Information Session was planned at the Marulan Memorial Hall on Friday 27th August 2021.

Due to the NSW Premier's recent announcement of the extension of the regional NSW lockdown, the decision has been made to cancel the second Community Information Session. This decision was made to ensure that current NSW restrictions are complied with and to reduce any potential risks to the local community. We apologise for any inconvenience this may cause.
